WHO WANTS TO BE A DIRECTOR?



Expressions of interest are called for from members who wish to try their hand at Directing. Without a Director there is no bridge.

NO DIRECTOR NO BRIDGE.

No Experience required but basic computing skills and a general knowledge of Bridge would be an asset.



LAW – PENALTY CARDS

A penalty card is a card that was prematurely exposed, but not led, by a defender.

There are MAJOR and MINOR penalty cards.

- (i)A minor penalty card is one ranked 2 9 that was inadvertently exposed. Once a defender has two penalty cards they both become MAJOR penalty cards.
- (ii) With a minor penalty card, a defender cannot play any card of the same suit below an honour card (ace

through to ten) unless they have first played the MINOR penalty card.

- (iii) When the offender is to play, a MAJOR penalty card must be played at the first legal opportunity, either in following suit, leading or discarding.
- (iv) When the partner of the offender with a MAJOR penalty card has the lead the declarer has three options:
- a) Ask for the lead of the suit of the exposed card, in which case the exposed is replaced in the hand.
- b) Deny the lead of the suit of the exposed card for as long as they retain the lead, in which case the exposed card is replaced in the hand.
- c) Give no lead restrictions, in which case the penalty card remains on the table and must be played at the first legal opportunity
