Mahatma Gandhi - The Indian spiritual leader was a passionate BRIDGE player, and is said to have even used bridge as a <u>metaphor</u> to illustrate foundational Hindu principles, such as the relationship between Kharma (predetermined events, or fatalism) and Dharma (human action and decision-making). Dharma, on the other hand, is represented by the player's gameplay decisions and the control that each person has over the outcome of the game.

Gandhi also said that the first time he ever felt the influence of God in his life was while playing in a bridge tournament in England. If that's not validation for the importance of card games, what is!?
